About CRNAs

CRNAs are anesthesia professionals who safely administer 43 million anesthetics annually in the United States. CRNAs have been providing anesthesia care in the United States for over 150 years.



Anesthesia Service Billing

The anesthetists providing your care are private practitioners, just like your ophthalmologist, therefore you will receive a separate bill for these professional services. Our professional fee includes preoperative evaluation, administration of your anesthetic and supervision of PACU stay.

For the vast majority of patients, we are able to file claims directly to your insurance company, or third party payer. You should know that because of deductibles and co-payment amounts, your insurer will often not pay the entire anesthesia professional fee. These charges are your responsibility, and ACP is bound by federal law to collect these payments.

Medicare patients: ACP accepts assignment on all Medicare patients. Medicare will reimburse 80% of the amount they consider reasonable for anesthesia services performed. The remaining 20% is your responsibility.
